### Public Works

- Fall Curbside Leaf Collection update: The department has begun the work in all areas (East, Central, West) to collect any remaining leaves. This third round leaf collection work task will continue until the leaf load on our street network is reasonably removed. As our leaf vacuum trucks will primarily be used for this task, for practical performance of the task, residents are encouraged to rake their leaves into piles as much as possible. Please do not mix other yard waste (gumballs, trash, small tree branches/limbs, brush, grass clippings, etc.) in with leaves and continue using the yard waste collection service for the disposal of other yard waste and contact the department office at (314) 505-8560 with any questions.
- No stickers are required for collection of yard waste until further notice.
- A Streets and Parks Renaming Task Force meeting was held on Monday, January 4 and passed a motion to determine tiered categories for proposed streets renaming. The Task Force work timeline has neared its wrapping up and report formulation phases. Consequentially another Streets and Parks Renaming Task Force meeting is scheduled for Monday, January 11 at 4:30 p.m. to continue the discussions and organize the Task Force's efforts up to the completion. The meeting is scheduled to be conducted on Zoom.
- A Commission on Storm Water Issues regular monthly meeting was held on Tuesday, January 5. The Commission discussed the Communication Plan presented by the Communication Subcommittee and authorized the Subcommittee to proceed; approved the Commission Bylaws; and discussed the Request For Qualifications for the Stormwater Master Plan.
