### Public Works

A Commission on Storm Water Issues regular monthly meeting was held on Tuesday, June 1. The discussion included a recap of the work on the US Army Corps Flood Risk Management Study and data transmittal to the Army Corps team, Relief Map update by Commissioner Holly, University City basin and channel areas data measurement and analysis update by Commissioner Criss and flood early warning system and communications subcommittee updates by Commissioner Stein. A discussion ensued on the Sherwood Lake in Overland and its possible downstream effect in University City and the arrangement of its inspection and evaluation by a team of Commissioners.
