Fall Curbside Leaf Collection is scheduled to return to the Central area on Monday, December 6, 2021 and will be performed in that work week. We ask that our residents rake their leaves to the curb line between the Friday before collection begins in your area and Monday 7 AM of your collection week. The truck will make only one pass per household. Please do not mix other yard waste (gumballs, trash, small tree branches/limbs, brush, grass clippings, etc.) in with leaves and continue using the yard waste collection service for the disposal of other yard waste and contact the department office at (314) 505-8560 with any questions.

Holiday lights recycling container will be available from Monday, December 6, 2021 to Friday, January 14, 2022 for our residents' use at the Fire Engine House #1 at 863 Westgate Ave. The container will be located in the enclosed foyer at the facility lobby past the outer entrance door.
