I learned on Friday, January 7, 2022, the company we contracted with to conduct the citizen satisfaction survey distributed a text message to the recipients of the mailed survey without my knowledge or approval. I have since approved the text message and the use of the link, although I believe mailing in the survey is the best method for sharing resident feedback. A second text message was sent this week reminding residents that received the survey to complete and return them to the ETC. The City of University City never receives a copy of the surveys – only the results from the survey. My sincere apology for any confusion this caused. I am assured this mishap will not impact the survey's validity.

Public Works

Solid Waste (trash, recycling and yard waste) collection service will not be provided on January 17th due to observance of Martin Luther King, Jr. Day. Monday collection routes will be completed on Tuesday, January 18th. All routes during the week of January 17th will be collected the day AFTER your normal collection day.
