**St. Louis County Offers Seniors Program
to Assist with Minor Home Repairs and Yard Work**

St. Louis County residents who are 60 years of age or older and need skilled **workers to tackle minor home repair and yard work** are invited to contact a program offered through Saint Louis County Department of Human Services. The County Older Resident Programs (CORP) Home Care and Repair program provides the names of skilled workers for a wide range of home repair and maintenance services, plus house cleaning and other chores. All workers are personally interviewed and subject to reference and police record checks. The program also tracks customer feedback to assure that work is completed in a satisfactory manner and workers are reputable, affordable and competent.

CORP Home Care and Repair workers are independent contractors who provide services such as interior/exterior painting, carpentry, air conditioning/heating repair and more. There is no charge to obtain the names of these individuals. However, fees for repair and maintenance services (often reduced for senior citizens) are negotiated between the customer and the worker.
